PROJECT BASED VOUCHER WAITING LIST IS OPEN

ROBERT O TOWNSEND SENIOR COMMUNITY 62+

The Housing Authority of the County of San Bernardino is accepting One (1) bedroom pre-applications for the Robert O Townsend project base community located in the City of Montclair. Applicants must be 62 years of age or older to apply.

What is the Project-Based Voucher Program?

It's a federal program that provides rental assistance for low and moderate-income households. Rental assistance for this program is based on a fixed 24% of the household total gross income. Applicants will be placed in order on the waiting list based on the date the application was received and any specified preferences. Veterans, the spouse of a veteran, widow or widower of a veteran will be given preference on the waiting list. Verification of veteran preference (i.e. DD214) is **required** at the time the application is submitted in order to receive the preference.

Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible for the project-based program, the total household income cannot exceed the HUD established income limits, and all household members must pass a criminal background screening. Households are assigned a unit based on 2 people per bedroom.

How can I apply?
