SAN BERNARDINO County agency gets grant for complex's solar panels

The Housing Authority of San Bernardino County scored a grant to install solar panels atop apartments in the announced Monday that it has Medical Center community.

Southern California Edison, combined with federal dollars, can be used for the \$2.4 million solar project. Housing officials reported the plan is to install panels on 96 apart-ments and three community buildings in the neighborhood. A \$1.84 million grant from

Medical Center Drive, on the Westside. There are 297 apart-ment units in the community. The Medical Center community is centered on the inter-section of Ninth Street and

on their electricity bills. Housing officials estimate that solar power will enable
