Access to Technology and Employment Resources for the Redlands Community *Computer Lab Open to the Public*

(San Bernardino, CA) After receiving a grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce to provide technology access to various communities throughout the County, the Housing Authority of the County of San Bernardino (HACSB) held an Open House at the Redlands computer lab on Wednesday, January 12th.

The computer lab is open to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. and is located at 131 East Lugonia Ave. The community can take advantage of access to technology and employment resources. The lab offer 14 computers both Windows and Apple Platforms, increased broadband speed, cover letter and resume writing assistance, job search and employment application assistance, GED information, and basic training on Microsoft Office programs.

The Housing Authority has also partnered with Career Institute, who has an on-site staff member once a week on Wednesdays to assist individuals with career, education, and life planning, with a special focus on resume writing, mastering interviewing skills, and job search strategies.

Upcoming classes include: Microsoft Word on January 17th from 10:00 – 11:30 a.m. and Microsoft Excel on January 18th from 10:00 – 11:30 a.m. Certificate will be issued upon completion of each class.
