9 COLLEGE STUDENTS AWARDED SCHOLARSHIPS

Housing Authority Provides \$13,500 in Assistance to Current Residents

(San Bernardino, CA) The Housing Authority of the County of San Bernardino (HACSB) awarded 9 students a college scholarship to help them pay for their education expenses. The selection committee reviewed almost 20 applications from Housing Authority clients, and narrowing the selection to 9 was a tough decision.

For 21 years, the Housing Authority has been awarding college scholarships to students, in a commitment to helping students succeed in college. Students attending a four-year college or university receive a \$1,500 scholarship while community and technical/vocational students receive a \$750 scholarship. The Housing Authority uses non-public funds to promote educational success among their participants.

This year's scholarship recipients are attending one of the following four-year colleges/universities: Biola University; Cal State University, San Bernardino; La Sierra University; Oakland University; University of California, Berkeley; and University of California, Riverside. Their areas of study include majors such as: anthropology, biology, criminal justice, nursing, political science, and psychology.

"As tuition rates continue to increase it's even more important for us to continue to fund the scholarship program for the students in our programs. These are small monetary contributions, but will alleviate some of the financial burden during their educational journey," states Dan Nackerman, HACSB's President/CEO. Tricia Favela one of the award recipients resonate Mr. Nackerman's message by saying: "I'm committed to completing my education and will do whatever it takes to ensure that any monies invested in me are a wise choice."

The Housing Authority's goal is to help all their residents achieve economic independence, and these winners as well as many other students in the housing programs are headed on a path towards this goal.
