8 COLLEGE STUDENTS AWARDED SCHOLARSHIPS

Housing Authority Provides \$9,750 in Assistance to Current Residents

(San Bernardino, CA) The Housing Authority of the County of San Bernardino (HACSB) awarded 8 students a college scholarship to help them pay for their education expenses. The selection committee reviewed several applications from Housing Authority clients, and narrowing the selection to 8 was a tough decision.

For 22 years, the Housing Authority has been awarding college scholarships to students, in a commitment to helping students succeed in college. Students attending a four-year college or university receive a \$1,500 scholarship while community and technical/vocational students receive a \$750 scholarship. The Housing Authority uses non-public funds to promote educational success among their participants.

This year's scholarship recipients are attending one of the following colleges/universities: Biola University; Cal State University, San Bernardino; Cal State University, Pomona; Loma Linda University; Praine View A&M University; University of California, Riverside, and San Bernardino Valley College. Their areas of study include majors such as: biology, business administration, human development, human nutrition and food, and nursing.

"The scholarship program offers a small monetary contribution to help our dedicated student-residents in their educational endeavors. We see them as role models for others and we are extremely proud of their accomplishments to date," states Dan Nackerman, HACSB's President/CEO.

Kathy Huynh states in her personal statement: "Being challenged in life is inevitable, but being defeated is optional." This demonstrates the tenacity of the scholarship recipients in achieving their goals.
