Sup. Gonzales also met with federal representatives **Harriet Tregoning**, Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary Community Planning & Development of HUD; and **Lisa Pape**, Exec. Director of Veterans Health Administration Homeless Program Office.

The goal of the visit was to advocate on behalf of the County of San Bernardino and share how the county is utilizing best practices and a comprehensive multi-agency effort in addressing homelessness in order to receive increased federal support to help solve local issues.
