

# Free Dental Clinic in San Bernardino



**CDA Cares is a two-day clinic** that provides dental services at no cost to people who have difficulty accessing dental care, including uninsured, underinsured or unemployed adults and children of any age. Identification is NOT required, and interpreters are on site to assist people who do not speak English.

**Dates:** **Thursday, September 26**  
3:30–6 p.m. – early registration only  
*A limited number of patients will be prescreened to begin treatment Friday at 5:30 a.m. Subject to change based on clinic set-up.*

**Friday, September 27**  
**Saturday, September 28**  
Doors open at 5:30 a.m.  
*An average of 1,950 people are seen on a first-come, first-served basis.*

Dental and health professionals donate their skills to provide cleanings, fillings, extractions, oral health education, assistance finding ongoing care and, on a limited basis, temporary partial dentures, dentures and root canals on front teeth.

## Reminders:

- A parent or guardian must accompany children younger than age 18.
- Uncontrolled blood pressure or diabetes may prevent you from receiving dental care. Take medications as prescribed and bring a complete prescription list.
- Do not wait for CDA Cares to seek care for dental pain. If pain is severe and accompanied by fever or swelling, call a dentist right away or go to an emergency room.
